CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN ENDANGERED SPECIES
OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA

signed at Washington on 3 March 1973

WITHDRAWAL OF RESERVATIONS BY CANADA

By note dated 14 April 1977, received on the 15 of the same month, the Embassy of Canada at Berne has notified the Federal Political Department of the decision of the Canadian Government to withdraw a number of reservations entered in accordance with Article XXIII on depositing its instrument of ratification of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora of 3 March 1973.

This withdrawal of reservations concerns the following species:
